May designed this class utilizing pre-made kits, as well as building a few of her own. All kit clubs featured are consistent in the types and amounts of product. These kit clubs were chosen by May for their excellence, but it is not a class requirement to purchase kits. You can substitute items from your own stash, use another kit club, or create your own kits at home each week.

**Note:** *The kits used all include patterned paper, cardstock, alphabet stickers or rub-ons, other stickers and/or rub-ons, and various small embellishments such as buttons, ribbon, and flowers.*



**To prepare for May's class please gather the following.**

- cardstock and patterned paper.
- embellishments such as ribbon, stickers, tags, buttons, and brads.
- letter stickers and/or rub-ons.
- photos.

**Note:** A digital kit by Katie Pertiet of [Designer Digitals](#) will be provided as a bonus in the fourth week of class. May will show ways of utilizing it with Microsoft Word, as well as directly printing without editing. No special software is required.

**Optional supplies:**

- ink pads.
- stamps (journaling, alphabet, shapes, or designs).
- sewing machine.
- chipboard letters or shapes.
- glitter.
- die cut/decorative patterned papers.
- other embellishments such as charms, memorabilia, small beads, brads, sequins, photo corners, etc.
- acrylic paint.
- punches (such as circle, star, border punch).
