When you do need help or additional materials, we believe the personal attention at your local scrapbook store can't be beat. We cannot guarantee the availability of every item on this list, but we work diligently with the [Scrapbook.com](https://www.scrapbook.com) team and appreciate their efforts to provide a convenient, one-stop resource online.

To prepare for Kolette's class, please gather the following:

- [Basic tool kit](#) (to purchase items like these [click here](#))
- Making Memories 6" x 9" chipboard mini book (landscape orientation) - comes with with 10 sheet protectors (I used the [green version](#) but others are available at the [Making Memories website](#)).

Note: Consider getting this particular album because the instructions throughout the workshop will utilize its unique landscape orientation. If this is not possible, you can use another landscape notebook (where it is wider than it is high) and adapt the instructions and worksheets to fit your size. You can also use an 8 1/2" x 11" notebook and rotate it so that the pages are turned landscape and it opens like a flipchart. The downloadable worksheets will be designed as 8 1/2" x 5 1/2" size.

- light- to medium-colored solid cardstock or “solid-ish” patterned paper/ cardstock to print daily quotes onto.
- four sheets of 12” x 12” patterned or solid cardstock for Quote Envelopes. You may also use policy envelopes or other letter-size envelopes if you do not want to make your own.
- ten to fifteen sheets lined notebook paper (amount depends on your personal journaling desires.)
- [acrylic paint](#).
- foam brushes.
- decorative stamps or rub-ons (Kolette Hall’s brand new [Post Script Clear Stamp Collection](#) is now available at [scrapbook.com](#). I used the following sets for The Art of Becoming More: [Dates & Flourishes](#), [Alphabet \(circles\)](#), [Journal Flourishes](#)).
- circle punches or circle cutter.
- [corner rounder](#).
- 1/4” or 1/8” hole punch.
- Japanese Screw Punch or eyelet setting tools.
- [paper piercer](#) [or thumb tack.
- [pop dots](#).
- [glue dots](#).
- [craft knife](#), mat, and [metal-edged ruler](#).
- ink pad.
- [journaling pen](#).
- [colored pencils](#) (optional).
- clear dry adhesive.

Note: please also gather the following coordinating products to complete your entire “Becoming More Notebook.” (I used various cardstocks, border stickers, buttons, journaling cards and embellishments from My Mind’s Eye [Très Jolie](#) collection for many of my pages)

- twenty to thirty sheets patterned or solid cardstock of your choice.
- ten to twenty sheets of white textured 8 1/2” x 11” cardstock for printing downloadable journaling cards and design elements. (You may also use light-colored muted patterned paper or solid cardstock).
- border embellishments such as stickers or die cuts. (I used My Mind’s Eye French Borders and [Doodlebug Paper Frills](#). Both come in a variety of colors or styles.)
- chipboard letters (I used [Heidi Swapp Chipboard Alphabets](#) and [American](#)

Crafts Thickers: both come in a variety of styles and/or colors. Thickers are also available in other materials.)

- alphabet sticker letters - various sizes including about 1/2" and 1" high. (I used [Basic Grey Letter Stickers](#).)
- flower embellishments. (These come in a variety of colors and sizes: [Heidi Swapp](#) large and small florals or [Imaginisce](#) blossoms) will work well.
- five to six yards of various ribbons.
- buttons.
- chipboard or die cut embellishments (such as parentheses, flowers, etc.).
- brads or eyelets.
- other embellishments of your choice. (These could include "bling," transparencies, string such as hemp or jute, photo corners, etc.)

Note: additional, separate supply lists will be available with each "Beyond the Notebook" project handout inside the classroom.
