To prepare for Talia's class, please gather the following supplies for a 12" x 12" baby album:

- [basic tool kit](#) (to purchase items like these [click here](#))
- [corner rounder](#).
- [sandpaper](#).
- [edge distresser](#).
- [brown ink](#).
- one 12" x 12" album with twenty page protectors.
- [twelve sheets white 12" x 12" textured cardstock](#).
- [thirty-six sheets colored 12" x 12" cardstock](#) (limit yourself to only two colors!).
- [twenty sheets 12" x 12" patterned paper](#) (limit yourself to only three to five different patterned papers!)
- [decorative tape](#) and/or [ribbon](#).
- two square envelopes (mine measure 5 1/2" x 5 1/2").
- coordinating accents and embellishments of your choice that are appropriate for a baby boy or a baby girl.

Note: When choosing paper and accents for your album, be sure that all the elements coordinate well together. They don't necessarily have to be from the same product line, just make sure that they compliment each other. Limit yourself to only two cardstock colors and only three to five patterned papers...less is more!
