### SUPPLY LIST

At Big Picture Scrapbooking, substitutions are encouraged! Our supply lists are designed to help you use what you have on hand. When you do need help or additional materials, we believe the personal attention at your local scrapbook store can't be beat. We are pleased to be in partnership with [Scrapbook.com](http://Scrapbook.com) to offer you a visual reference to tools and products you will need to gather. We cannot guarantee the availability of every item on this list, but we work diligently with the [Scrapbook.com](http://Scrapbook.com) team and appreciate their efforts to provide a convenient, one-stop resource online.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Because of the adaptable nature of this project, you will need to adjust the supply list to fit your needs. Kolette will give further instruction and offer examples during Week 1 of the workshop. If you choose to wait until then before you purchase supplies, you will be fine. The list below will give you an idea of what supplies you will need, but there is ample opportunity to make adjustments when you plan your album during Week 1.

#### To prepare for Kolette's workshop, please gather the following:

- [Basic tool kit](#) (to purchase items like these [click here](#))
- 8" x 8" or 9" x 9" (or similar size) album with top-loading sheet protectors - album should contain enough sheet protectors to fit one or two pages for each family member that you include in your album.

#### Options to consider:

- [Making Memories 9" x 9"](#) (this is the album I used)

- album sheet protector refills (if needed).
- 1/8" and/or 1/4" hole punches.
- light box or other light source for tracing Kolette's handwritten design.
- journaling pen (black or brown).
- cardstock for mounting photos and printing individual responses. Consider white, 8 1/2" x 11" size for easy printing.
- twenty to forty cardstocks, depending upon the number of pages you will create for your album. If you use an album with ten sheet protectors, you will have twenty pages. There will be a title page and an ending page, leaving eighteen pages for "grandchildren." That number will be adjusted according to how many people you would like to include in your album and whether you use one or two pages per person. The quantities of your supplies greatly depend on the number of pages you create to meet your family's needs.
- six yards of coordinating ribbon and/or trim (use a variety of styles).
- small brads, eyelets, and jewels.
- heart embellishment or die-cut for final page.
- hanging charm for front cover (optional - will be tied to front cover with ribbon).
- medium-size bookplate (optional - will also be tied to front cover with ribbon).
- if possible, a 4" x 6" (or similar size) photo of grandparent(s) or person whom your album is celebrating. You can also use 2 separate smaller photos if you do not have a photo of both grandparents together.
- recent 4" x 6" (or similar size) photo of each person included in your album.
- response sheet information from each person included in your album (Response Sheet Template included in Pre-Workshop download available immediately following registration).
- computer for printing individual responses (it is possible to handwrite these if you do not have access to a computer).
