### Other Supplies

- masks or stencils.
- **scissors.**
- **colored embossing powder.**
- **ribbon.**
- **patterned paper.**
- screenprint transparency (I used one from Hambly Studios).
- **rub-ons.**
- **Cuttlebug** and **Embossing Folders** Leafy Branch and Stylized Flowers.
- plastic comb (like the kind at the drugstore that men with comb-overs use).
- buttons.
- foam stamp(s).
- popsicle sticks.
- dictionary pages or old book pages.
- white opaque pen.
- one 8 1/2" x 11" piece of chipboard (hint: use the piece that comes in your pack of Sticky Back Canvas).
- one package of eyelets (we'll use approx 25 eyelets).
- eyelet setting tool (**Crop-a-Dile** or other).
- one saw tooth picture hanger.
- four **1/8" jump rings.**
- **rubber stamps** (clear or red rubber is fine).
- nine Bazzil 2" x 2" chipboard squares.
- one 8" x 8" stretched canvas.

### Book:

- 4" x 4" chipboard binder book (I used one from **Maya Road**).

The weekly "Quick Project " supplies will use mostly items from this list, but some new supplies such as cardstock or findings may be added as the class evolves. I am big on using things that you already have on hand, so suggestions will be made on what you can use that might already be in your supplies.



**Now that you have your list, here's what to do!**

- First, shop your stash! At Big Picture Scrapbooking, substitution is encouraged! We hope you'll adapt this supply list to make use of what you already have on hand.
