To prepare for Lisa's class, please gather the following:

- a [Basic tool kit](#) (to purchase items like these [click here](#))
- Exclusive [Scrapsupply abum](#).
- [sandpaper or sanding block](#).
- [acrylic paints and foam brushes](#).
- one shaped rubber stamp. I used a circle.
- alphabet stamps in two fonts: one medium and one large.
- inks for edging (I used [Cat's Eye inks](#)) and stamping ([Staz-On](#)).
- rub-on alphabets: two fonts, large and small.
- rub-on sentiments that may apply to the Who, What, Where, When and Why you scrapbook.
- patterned papers. (I used coordinating papers from different manufacturers.)
- assorted embellishments in no more than two categories. I used clear embellishments and jewels or rhinestones.
- journaling cards or journaling stamps to make cards.
