Master Supply list

To prepare for Kolette's class, please gather the following:

General Supplies

- coordinating papers or colored cardstock.
- white cardstock.
- 1/4" hole punch.
- permanent journaling pen such as Sharpie brand.
- scallop scissors - various sizes (optional).
- pop dots adhesive (optional).
- craft knife and cutting mat.
- ruler.
- sandpaper.
- 1", 1 1/2", 2" circle punches or circle cutter.



Preclass Handout

- 9"x9" Bare Naked Chipboard Album (with 6 tabbed pages) by BoBunny Press.
- 9"x 9" sheet protectors by BoBunny Press (these fit the chipboard album perfectly).
- Maya Mist or spray paint of your choice.
- journaling blocks of your choice (Kolette used Maya Road Sheer Office Notes but you can use journaling stamps, die cuts or chipboard.) Choices similar to Kolette's include: American Crafts Remarks Stickers, Hambly Studios Overlay Transparency Journaling Bits or Heidi Swapp Journaling Spots.
- four sheets coordinating black and white patterned paper.
- mask (I used the Heidi Swapp Butterfly Mask).
- spiral journaling book - 5th Avenue Collection by Making Memories.
- chipboard mini shapes (I used Heidi Swapp's variety pack).
- circle mirror by Heidi Swapp (I used one that was 1 1/2" wide).
- your initials in foam stamps or stickers (about 1 1/2" high).
- 24" of about 1" wide ribbon.
- 8" string or thin hemp (optional).
- one My Big Fat Word Chipboard Album - Arrow shape by BoBunny Press.
- silver acrylic paint (optional).
- black ink pad (optional).

1st Life Tunes Handout

- we will use the backside of the Arrow Chipboard page you started in the Pre-class handout as well as the first tabbed chipboard page that came with your binder.
- one 1/4" foam sheet (available at Wal-Mart in the children's craft section).
- three monochromatic or coordinating **acrylic paint** colors of your choice.
- white **acrylic paint**.
- four foam brushes or cosmetic sponges.
- about 1" tall foam alphabet stamps.
- **journaling blocks** of your choice (Kolette used Maya Road Sheer Office Notes but you can use journaling stamps, die cuts or chipboard.) Choices similar to Kolette's include: American Crafts Remarks Stickers, Hambly Studios Overlay Transparency Journaling Bits or Heidi Swapp Journaling Spots.
- paper towels or baby wipes.



2nd Life Tunes Handout

- three to four coordinating **pattern papers** or cardstock.
- fifteen to twenty **small flowers** (about 1/2"-1" size).
- 5" x 7" landscape photo of a person important to you.



3rd Life Tunes Handout

- two or three coordinating **pattern papers** or **cardstock** (select a muted pattern - you will be printing on these).
- large embellishment (I used **Heidi Swapp's XL Ghost Shape - Bird**, but you can use a large flower or another embellishment that is about 4" wide).
- coordinating **acrylic paint** and foam brush (optional - if you are using a Heidi Swapp ghost shape, then you will probably want to have some paint on hand to embellish it).
- **Tim Holtz Game Spinner** or other small arrow-shaped embellishment (optional).



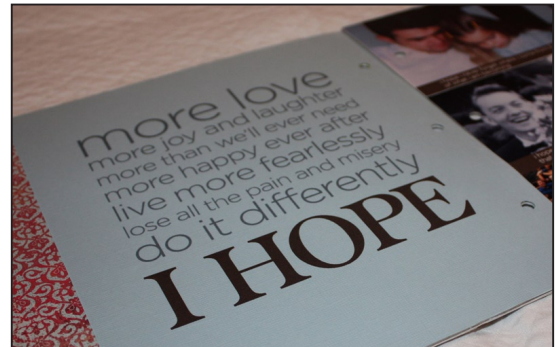
4th Life Tunes Handout

- two 9" x 4" strips coordinating **pattern papers** or **cardstocks** (one should be a muted pattern for printing).
- two coordinating but **contrasting papers** (small or muted patterns - scraps are fine).
- 12" **ribbon**.
- 10" x 5" horizontal photo of yourself (you can have one printed 8" x 10" and trim it down) - consider taking one off-center so that you are on the right side of the photo.



5th Life Tunes Handout

- **"My Big Fat Word" Album by Bo Bunny - Arrow shape** (or an arrow shape of your choice).
- one **cardstock** sheet for printing on.
- one coordinating 2" strip of **cardstock** or **patterned paper**.
- cardstock for journaling strips (can write by hand or use the computer).
- one to six photos representing things you hope for (I used three photos).



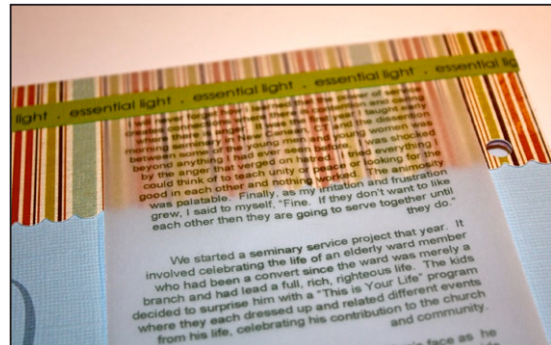
6th Life Tunes Handout

- **cardstock** sheets for backgrounds on each page (one sheet will be printed on).
- 1" x 1" squares of various colors of cardstock.
- three to six small embellishments of your choice - smaller than 1" (I used two Heidi Swapp **mini chipboard shapes**, a spiral paper clip, a small flower, a button and string, a decorative brad and a small metal letter - all were in my stash).
- ink pad for inking edges (optional).
- corner rounder (optional).
- one to five photos of yourself - all 1"x 1" in size.



7th Life Tunes Handout

- solid cardstock sheet (will be printed on - I used two different colors).
- one coordinating patterned paper or cardstock sheet.
- one sheet vellum for printing journaling. (Can also use transparency sheet. Cardstock can work as well).



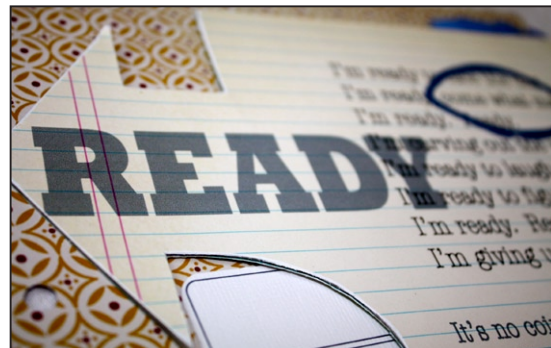
8th Life Tunes Handout

- two coordinating cardstocks or patterned papers.
- 15" coordinating ribbon.
- photo of yourself - (but make it something that represents your individuality and uniqueness. I used a 3" x 5" size image).



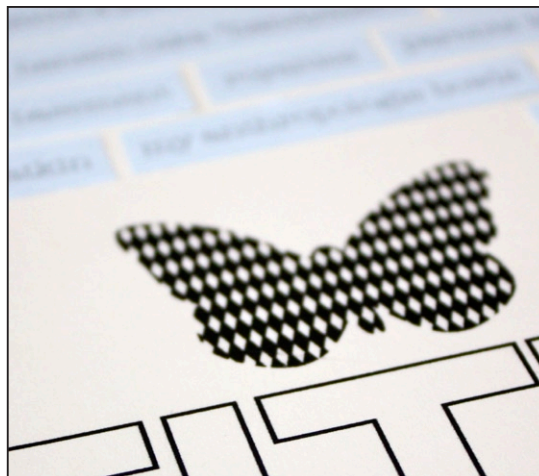
9th Life Tunes Handout

- two coordinating cardstocks or patterned papers.
- 6" each of three to four styles of coordinating ribbon or trim.
- empty paper towel or toilet paper tube.
- coordinating acrylic paint.
- chipboard or sticker letters.
- two large flowers (I used 5" diameter).
- one medium-sized flower (I used 2 1/4" diameter).
- large button (about 3/4").
- photo of yourself - 4" x 4".



10th Life Tunes Handout

- muted patterned paper scraps (I used black papers with white patterns).
- two off-white **cardstock** sheets for printing (or other color of your choice).
- **chipboard** or stickers (for the number "100").
- light colored cardstock for printing phrases (I used an ice-blue color).



11th Life Tunes Handout

- three coordinating **patterned papers** or **cardstock** (I used a muted pattern to print on and my accent papers were lined and patterned).
- transparency sheet (optional).
- die cut letter embellishment for the first letter of your last name.
- 8" thin **ribbon**.
- four to five photos of what "home" means to you (I used a photo of our house, our little family, Jason and Coleman).



12th Life Tunes Handout

- two coordinating **patterned papers** or **cardstock**.
- various coordinating **ribbons** (about 1 yard total).
- Diamond Dust or other **clear glitter** (optional).
- **clear liquid glue** (optional).
- 3-5 photos of what "peace" means to you (I used a photo of my hobbies and Coleman).
