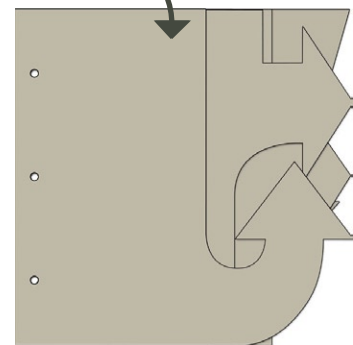

- Basic tool kit (to purchase items like these [click here](#))
- [9" x 9" BoBunny Bare Naked Binder](#).
- circle-shaped CD holder ([Swing brand Solo CD Case](#) is a good choice).
- [ATC card holder by 7gypsies](#) (approximately 6" high).
- [metal tin lunchbox](#) or [recipe box](#) ([Maya Road](#) has many options also).
- 8" x 8" album.
- [Maya Road Heart Sheer Binder](#) (or other [heart-shaped album](#)).
- coordinating pattern papers
- single-sided and double-sided patterned cardstocks.
- solid cardstock.
- [ATC clear transparency letters by 7 gypsies](#).
- Bo Bunny 9" x 9" My Word Arrow Album Chipboard Refill Kit (MWA376). ***Note:** this is brand new product; availability updates will be communicated with in the classroom.
- [ribbon](#) (various widths and patterns).
- [8 1/2" x 11" white cardstock for printing](#).
- ink pads.
