- precision-tipped scissors
- paper-to-paper adhesive (glue stick)
- photo adhesive (tape runner)
- black journaling pens (in sizes .03 and .08)
- pencil
- art gum eraser
- see-through ruler
- paper piercer
- craft knife

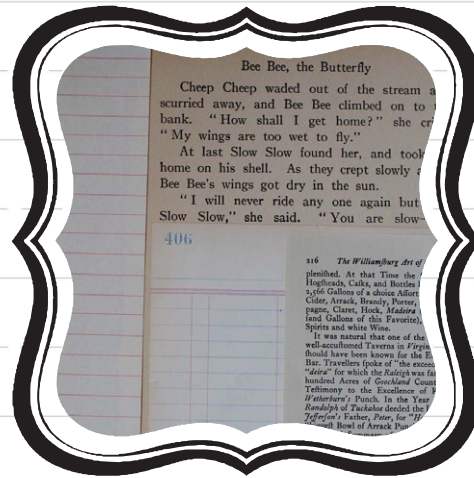
To prepare for Jenni’s class, please gather the following tools and supplies:
