Note from Jen:

The supplies are organized in two specific areas in *Saving Your Sanity: Throughout the Holidays*.

- **supplies and tools you may need to purchase** - the supplies you will want to have on hand prior to beginning our class.
- **stash supplies** - supplies that you may easily find in your stash, but may need to be replenished.



I have also listed tools that I use that are COMPLETELY optional. Do NOT feel like you must have ALL of the optional supplies to complete this class, because you can create everything without them.

I absolutely encourage you to use what you have in your own creative stash as additional embellishments to the projects, pages, and albums you will create in this class.

To prepare for Jen's class, please gather the following:

Supplies and tools you may need to purchase:

- [scoring board](#) - I have the Martha Stewart Board (useful but optional).
- [heat gun](#) (optional).
- sewing machine (optional, but fun and time saving!).
- [hot glue gun](#) and [glue sticks](#) - I prefer the low temp style.
- [label maker](#) (optional).
- [Crop-a-Dile Anywhere Punch](#).
- stapler.
- [paper piercer](#).
- foam paintbrushes.
- fine tip paintbrush.
- [binding machine](#) (optional) - I use The Cinch by We R Memory Keepers; you can easily use Kinko's to bind or book binding rings instead of the spiral binding.
- Inexpensive 4" x 6" brag book album - I picked mine up at Target for \$1.99!
- [5" x 8" pad of lined paper](#).
- [5" x 8" file box](#).
- [5" x 8" index cards](#).
- 5" x 8" tabbed dividers.
- page protectors.
- [acrylic paints](#).
- [Glossy Accents \(optional\)](#).
- [one 6 1/2" foam wreath form](#).
- [five 6" x 6" canvas art frames](#).
- [circle tin](#).
- [one 12" x 12" shadow box](#).
- [two 12" x 24" canvas art frames](#).
- straight pins.
- [1/4" elastic](#).
- art hanging hardware.

Stash supplies:

- stamps.
- five sheets of [chipboard](#) or several cereal boxes - I love to recycle!
- twenty sheets of color coordinating [cardstock](#) (project specific) and several additional sheets (for accents on a variety of projects).
- twenty sheets of white [cardstock](#) (project specific) and several additional sheets of white, kraft and neutral colors (that will coordinate with your color scheme for accents on a variety of projects).
- coordinating [patterned paper](#) in fall and winter colors.
- chipboard shapes.
- your favorite embellishments - some of my favorites: ribbon, stickers, tags, rub-ons, office supplies, buttons, brads, eyelets and chipboard.

Now that you know what you need, here is what we suggest:

1. Shop your stash. At Big Picture Scrapbooking we encourage you to use what you have and make substitutions as often as you can.
