May has thought a LOT about her fellow scrapbookers in the Southern Hemisphere, too, and suggests two ways to adapt her seasonal focus:

- Scrapbookers in the Southern Hemisphere might choose to scrap seasonally with May, regardless of the month they are experiencing.
- Or, scrapbookers in the Southern Hemisphere might want to adapt May's sketches and color schemes to document their lives in the month she focuses on.
