To prepare for Amy's class, please gather the following:

- [basic tool kit](#) (to purchase items like these [click here](#))
- two sheets cardstock.
- one sheet [Basic Grey Blush Boyfriend](#) (or a patterned paper of your choice).
- one sheet [Basic Grey Blush Fancy](#) (or a patterned paper of your choice).
- one sheet [Basic Grey Blush Mini Monograms](#) (or other coordinating letters of your choice).
- One [Color Box Fluid Chalk Cat's Eye Inkpad](#), in Aquamarine (or another ink color that coordinates with your chosen papers).
- one sheet galvanized steel, 11" x 15", which can be purchased at your local hardware store (located in the HVAC section alongside the metal duct working).

bigtip: Detailed instructions for purchasing the galvanized steel from the hardware store are included in the class handout. I purchased a 24" x 36" sheet of galvanized steel and asked the hardware store to cut it to size. This gave me enough steel to make four memo boards for less than \$7.00.

- foam brush.
- decoupage medium. I used [Modge Podge Matte Finish](#) from Plaid.



Bonus Mini Project Supply List

- scraps of patterned paper from project.
- paper flowers. I used American Crafts, Greenhouse, Sally Large Paper.
- button magnets: purchase these at the hardware store when you buy your steel.
- clear floral marbles (look for the ones that are flat on one side).
- hot glue gun.
