

## Yesterday & Today

### Master Supply List

**Note from Ali:** The emphasis of Yesterday & Today is on words + photos scrapbooking. This means the process will be less about working with products and more about the images and the story that goes along with them. I absolutely encourage you to use what you have in your own creative stash as additional elements on your layouts.

#### To prepare for Yesterday & Today, please gather the following:

- **Photoshop Elements** (or other photo editing program)  
Some of the downloads you will receive can be added directly to your photos in a photo editing program (these steps will be covered during the workshop). Photos can be uploaded to your favorite developer or printed at home.
- **Ink Jet Printer**  
During class, you will be able to download digital elements to be used on your layouts. You will also be encouraged to document longer stories (and I find it is easier to type these sorts of stories). A 8 1/2" x 11" ink jet printer is just fine for these purposes. I use a HP Photosmart printer that has been a workhorse for me over the past few years. I use it for printing photos, titles, and other embellishments.
- **Scanner**  
The scanner is for importing and enlarging older photos that you may not have digitally. I recommend not using original photos for any creative work. During class, I will walk you through the process I use to scan, enlarge, and print my older photos.
- **Small notebook**  
I recommend selecting a small notebook to keep with you to jot down story ideas as they start coming to you throughout this class. I have a couple of small notebooks that I keep in my purse, and encourage you to choose whatever works for your lifestyle.

- [American Crafts 12" x 12" D-Ring album](#) (any color, any style).
- One package [12" x 12" divided page protectors](#).
- One package [American Crafts 6" x 12" page protectors](#).
- [Ultra Mega Square Punch](#) (2 1/2" x 2 1/2")  
This is a new, larger version of the classic square punch. You can definitely trim photos and patterned paper to this size using a trimmer/craft knife rather than spending money on this. I like this punch, however, for ease of use.
- [Paper Shapers large corner rounder punch](#).  
Any corner rounder you have will be just fine.
