Destination: Childhood is designed for traditional or digital scrapbookers, but if you want to take full advantage of the digital elements, you will need Photoshop or Photoshop Elements software. A 30-day free trial of Photoshop is available at <http://www.adobe.com/downloads/>.

I will provide supplies and instructions for digital scrapbookers, but scrapbooking digitally is completely optional in this class. If you are not a digital scrapbooker, you will only need Microsoft Word or MAC Pages for basic word processing.

To prepare for Cynthia's class, please gather the following supplies:

Basic Supplies:

- one 8 1/2" x 11" **album** (I used [American Crafts Modern d-ring album](#) in black).

- ten sheets of 8 1/2" x 11" kraft

Note: I prefer [Bazzill kraft cardstock](#), though it only comes in packets of 25 sheets. It is always a great basic to have on hand.

- five sheets of coordinating **patterned paper**.
- five sheets of coordinating solid colored **cardstock**.
- ten sheets of 8 1/2" x 11" off-white or other light-colored **cardstock** (to print journaling on).

Optional Supplies:

- one package of [Making Memories tag maker square rims](#) or the [Making Memories tag tool kit with rims](#).
- one Studio Calico Children Silhouettes clear stamp set or any vintage child themed stamp.
- one [Tim Holtz Distress inkpad \(Black Soot\)](#).
- inkjet printer to print journaling and album spine tag.
- scanner (to scan vintage photos).

Note to Digital Scrapbookers: I will be providing you with PS or PSE layered templates, custom digital background patterned paper and a class logo PNG file to further customize your layouts. If you prefer to do the entire project digitally, you will need these additional supplies, along with Adobe Photoshop Elements or Photoshop.

- one digital pattern paper kit of your choice (I used [Kitschy Digitals Calico Dream Digital Kit](#)).
- one set of coordinating color digital cardstock (optional).

Now that you know what you need, here is what we suggest:

1. Shop your stash. At Big Picture Scrapbooking we encourage you to use what you have and make substitutions as often as you can.
