To prepare for Nic's class, please gather the following:

- [cardstock](#).
- [patterned paper](#).
- [alphabet chipboard](#), stickers and/or rub-ons.
- [embellishments](#) such as chipboard, decorative rub-ons, gems, flowers, transparencies and brads.
- assorted [journaling pens](#).
- [pop-dots](#) or [dimensional foam](#).
- ink pads, my preferred are the ColorBox Catseye chalk inks.
- corner rounder.
- [punches](#) (such as border punches etc).
- [sandpaper](#).
- paint.
- water brush or paint brush with water available.
- photos.



Additional Supplies used occasionally throughout the workshop:

- stamps.
- [chipboard](#).
- sewing machine.
- paint.
- glimmermist.
- glitter.
- [ribbon](#).
- [hole punch](#).
- memorabilia (if applicable for any of your layouts).
