

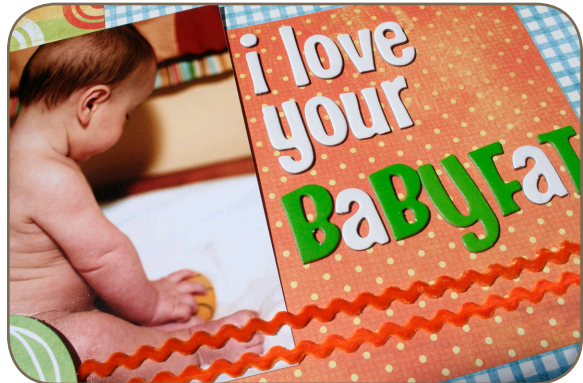
## Don't Blink

### Scrapbooking Your Baby's First Year

To prepare for Jessica's class, please gather the following:

- 12" x 12" scrapbook paper
- embellishments that you like - ribbon, chipboard, stickers, etc.
- letters for titles - I personally love [Thickers](#) and use them on the majority of my layouts, but you can also use letter stickers, chipboard, grungeboard or even your computer.
- journaling cards - Dozens of options exist, so pick whatever you like.
- [Xyron 250 Create A Sticker Maker](#) - The 250 makes adhering ribbon and embellishments so quick and easy. I use it on almost every page.
- [Xyron Create-A-Sticker - Model 150 "X" Dispenser](#) - If I just have ribbon or something small to put on a page, I use the X. It is great, quick and easy, which are three qualities that matter when you are a mom and don't have a lot of time.



I can't stress enough that your baby's first album should be made with products that YOU love. But, as a Type-A individual, I also understand how it can be helpful to know what the teacher has used and loved. ☺ So, the following is a list of some of my favorite brands/products that you may also like to use in your album, along with a bit of commentary about each.

- [American Crafts - D-ring albums](#) - I love D-ring albums because although I don't scrapbook chronologically, I want my layouts in my baby's album to be chronological. D-ring albums allow me to easily move pages around.
- [Making Memories - Animal Crackers](#) - This is my favorite baby line! I have double and triple of just about everything in the collection. Just buy it all and thank me later. This paper is PERFECT for any baby album.
- [Die Cuts With A View - Nana's Nursery Baby Boy/Baby Girl Collections](#) - This is another great baby line that offers a wide selection of papers and fun embellishments.
- [Cosmo Cricket - Jack's World](#) - You can't go wrong with Cosmo Cricket. Their collections are amazing. This was one that I used a lot of in my son's baby album.
- [Sassafras Lass - Bungle Jungle](#) - This line from Sassafras Las features adorable animals and its bright colors make it perfect for a baby album.
- [Fancy Pants - About a Boy collection](#) - This collection would totally work for girls too!
- [Fancy Pants - Splendid collection](#) - This line will work for boys or girls and is perfect for those love you layouts.
- Fancy Pants - 12" x 12" felt - You get so many great embellishments in these kits. My favorites are [Rough and Tough](#) and [Sassy](#).
- Hambly Studios - These are my favorite transparencies. I especially love their new [onesie transparencies](#) and [classic animals rub-ons](#).



- **Creating Keepsakes - Sweet Baby Kit** - If you are looking for one kit that will enable you to make a beautiful coordinated first year album for your baby, this is the kit to get. It has EVERYTHING you need. I actually am making this kit's month-by-month album in addition to the layouts I share in this class. I can't say enough about this kit. I LOVE it.
