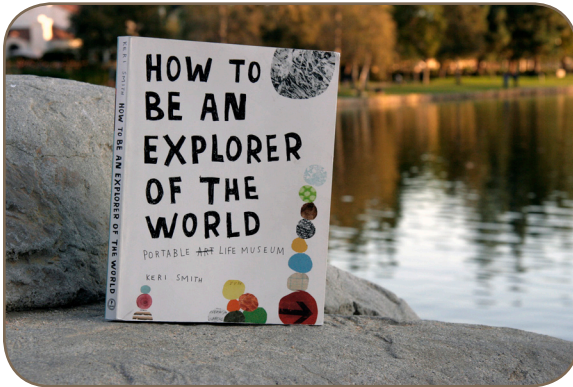

To prepare for Tami's class, please gather the following:

- [How to be an Explorer of the World](#) by Keri Smith
- a sense of adventure!
- a camera
- a variety of [cardstock](#), [patterned paper](#), and [embellishments](#) from your stash
- some sort of notebook, binder, or album for your field notes, in any size you like. (I used a mix of different papers, spiral-bound with the [Bind-it-All](#) and covered with an [8" x 8" Cover-All](#) by Zutter.)

Other journal ideas:

- a 3-ring binder, decorated to your liking
- a spiral-bound sketch pad with ribbons tied to the binding
- a composition book
- your own innovative creation

It is extremely helpful to have access to a photo printer (either at home, or an instant photo kiosk at a local store), or an instamatic camera, so you can have the gratification of adding photos to your field journal on a daily basis.
