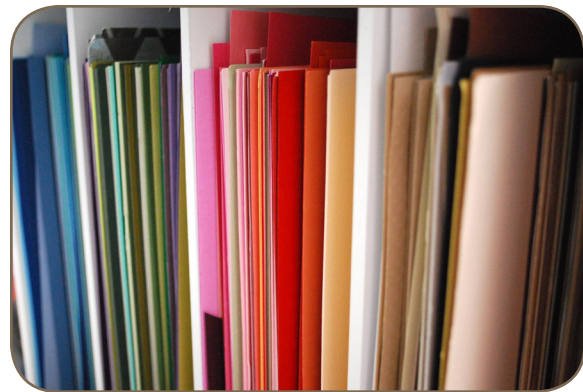


Extraordinary Paper

- assorted journaling pens (various colors and sizes) - my favorite is the [American Crafts slick writer](#)
- photos



Optional supplies:

- embellishments such as ribbon, tags, buttons, flowers, and brads
- letter stickers and/or rub-ons
- acrylic paint
- ink pads
- stamps
- sewing machine
- punches (such as [circle](#), [square](#), [heart](#), [star](#), [border punch](#), [corner rounder](#))
- [decorative scissors](#)
