To prepare for Mou's class, please gather the following:

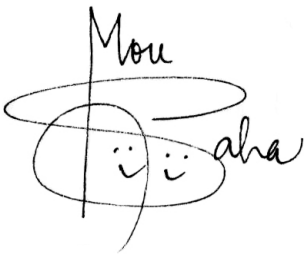
- [basic tool kit](#).
- pencil and eraser.
- paintbrush.
- [bone folder](#).
- [7 Gypsies Collage Tissue: Life](#).
- [Faber-Castell Design Memory Crafts ART GRIP Aquarelle watercolor pencils](#).
- [Faber-Castell Design Memory Crafts PITT artists pens](#) for writing.
- [Faber-Castell Design Memory Crafts PITT artists pens](#) brush tip for coloring.
- We R Memory Keepers 6" x 6" designer book board - chipboard (two pieces).
- [Strathmore watercolor paper 140lb cold press](#).
Note: you can buy these in pads at your local art and craft supply store. Please try to get a good quality pad as the heavy weight paper is crucial to creating a sturdy book. Moreover, watercolor techniques work best with this type of paper.
- [Scotch 3M wrinkle-free glue stick](#).
Note: this particular glue stick is helpful for attaching tissue paper to chipboard.
- [adhesive tape](#).
- one sheet 12" x 12" double-sided patterned paper or cardstock of your choice.
- white letter stickers, any font of your choice.
- one sheet of mini [alphabet stickers](#).



A note on watercolor paper: Even though you may not find watercolor paper at your local scrapbook store, you can easily find them at your local art supplies store. They come in various sized pads. A 9" x 12" pad of 140 lb. cold press watercolor paper will work well for this project.

A note on watercolor pencils: If you already have another type of watercolor pencils that you want to use, that will work just fine. The watercolor paper is the only component that I'd like you to include because the techniques you'll learn will work best with good quality watercolor paper.
