To prepare for Lisa's class, please gather the following:

- Photos, letters and other memorabilia from the life of a person you'd like to pay tribute to.
- An album that will easily accommodate the amount of material (photos and stories) you have.
- Cardstock, pattern papers, letter stickers or rub-ons and embellishments that remind you of the person for whom you are creating this tribute.

I strongly encourage handwritten journaling in this album. Having several [archival pens](#) in various point sizes is encouraged.

I cannot wait to help you get started—and finished on this very important project.



Please NOTE: Lisa's tribute album is dedicated to her Aunt Dana, who died of cancer in 2000. This class is particularly well suited to helping you also create a special tribute to someone you've lost, however you can use Lisa's concept and direction to celebrate the life of anyone you love.
