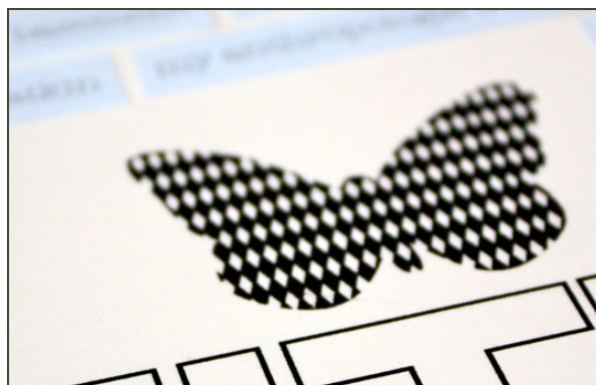

We will use the back of September’s tabbed page and the final arrow page. If you are just joining us then you can make the layout using any size you choose as a stand-alone layout.
