To prepare for Nic's class, please gather the following:

- [Basic tool kit](#).
- scallop scissors.
- 1/8 " hole punch or [Crop-o-dile](#).
- [journaling pen](#), pencil, and ruler.
- [Colorbox chalk ink](#) - dark brown and creamy brown.
- sandpaper.
- runner type adhesive.
- glue dots.

- stamps (suggestions include florals and flourishes).
- a small amount of paint and a foam brush.
- 6" x 6" acrylic album.
- one transparency overlay.
- two sheets of coordinating 12" x 12" patterned paper.
- one sheet of coordinating 12" x 12" decorative edged paper.
- one sheet of coordinating cardstock or solid color patterned paper.
- eight to ten sheets of coordinating 6" x 6" (or smaller) die-cut type papers.
- one to two sheets of [alphabet stickers](#).
- eight to ten colored decorative rub-ons (suggestions include quotes or phrases).
- a collection of small die-cut shapes.
- a collection of embellishments (suggestions include buttons, bling, florals, thread).
- photos, of course!
